Range Rules

- 1. No vehicles, except work details, are permitted on the ranges while in use.
- 2. Enter ranges from access area only. No climbing over backstops or walls. No spectators are permitted on range walls while ranges are in use.
- 3. Members using ranges will sign in and list all guests using ranges. Members are responsible for their guests.
- 4. No one under 16 years of age is permitted to use the ranges without adult supervision.
- 5. All guests must be accompanied by a member in good standing.
- 6. All club members are authorized to request proof of membership.
- 7. Non-members must use the same bench or position as their sponsor.
- 8. No hunting or shooting at wildlife on or from the ranges.
- 9. NO ONE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OR NARCOTICS IS PERMITTED TO USE RANGES, BE ON THE RANGES OR OBSERVE FROM THE SPECTATOR AREA. NO INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OR NARCOTICS ARE PERMITTED ON THE RANGES OR IN THE SPECTATOR AREA.
- 10. No full or selective fire automatic weapons are allowed on the grounds without the approval of the range master or club officers.
- 11. No clay bird shooting on the rifle or handgun range.
- 12. Only paper targets are to be used. Cans, bottles, etc. are never permitted.
- 13. Shooting at targets or objects on the ground is never permitted.
- 14. Ranges are to be used on approved days during hours established by the club.
- 15. Shooting booths must be used for certain calibers of handguns and rifles as established by the club. Check before using ranges.
- 16. When shooting booths are in use, no one is permitted beyond the firing line.
- 17. When ranges are in use, shooting booths are to be entered from the back. No one is permitted to enter the booths from the front or side.

- 18. Booths and ranges are to be kept clean from all debris. After shooting, pick up all brass and remove all targets.
- 19. Clear the line and be sure all weapons are open and down before proceeding down range. No handling of firearms, while anyone is down range.
- 20. Any firearms having mechanical problems or are otherwise unsafe are to be immediately removed from the range.
- 21. Any gun repairs, other than sight adjustments, are to be done off the line, while the firearm is in a safe condition.
- 22. During club sponsored shoots the range may be closed to all persons, except to those participating in the shoot.
- 23. At all times, the fundamentals of firearm safety must be observed.

These rules may be subject to change or may be amended in the future. Any violation of these rules may result in suspension of range privileges. All club members are expected to follow and assist in ensuring these rules are followed.

Shooting Hours

NO SHOOTING: Easter Sunday and Christmas Day.

SHOOTING DAYS/HOURS: Monday through Saturday 9:00 am until dusk; Sunday 10:00 am until dusk.

Exceptions to the shooting hours will be considered for official shoots.
